Comment:

- Active members i.e. those who successfully rode at least one brevet of any distance = 616 (down from 654 for the Paris-Brest-Paris year of 2010/11)
- Still a huge number of members (720 or 54%) who complete no brevets
- Still a large proportion of active members who complete only 1 x 200km or longer ride each year.

Non-Member Participation

Non-member participation continues to be concentrated on the Alpine Classic representing 1153 of the 2071 non-member brevets (56%).

Pedal Power's Fitz's Challenge accounted for a further 192 non-member homologated brevets and Newcastle Overnight 128.

More than 98% of non-members complete 2 or less brevets. Records only identify for some rides whether non-members are members of other Cycling Australia affiliated clubs; the Alpine Classic and Fitz's Challenge in particular do not identify CA members from other non-members.

The incidence of riders saving money by riding multiple times as temporary members in preference to paying the membership fee and a lower ride entry fee, would appear to be zero.
