### Weather / Traffic Conditions:

The weather gods were very kind and presented us with a mild and sunny winter day, with light winds in the morning, freshening a bit in the afternoon. The morning temperature of approx. 11 degs C at the start climbed steadily to reach 20 degs C in the afternoon. Moderate traffic on Brookton Hwy and Albany Hwy, otherwise light traffic on the minor roads.

**General Comments:** Is there a perfect date or idea for making the ride a greater success next year.

12 riders assembled at the start, 7 for the 200 km and 5 for the 100 km. The first 25 km from the start to Soldiers Road had to be changed on short notice, due to road works on Lady McNess Drive. Therefore we approached Soldiers Road from the West which added another 4 km of climbing up Brookton Hwy. This ride was a tough one, especially Canning Mills Rd was quite a challenge for me. But once you're on top of the hill you're smiling again - until the next one.
