



Audax Australia Risk Management Policy

The Audax Australia Cycling Club was established to promote and run “Audax Cycling” – defined in our Constitution as “long distance cycling events, which are not races, and which have their foundation in the style of events promoted by Audax Club Parisien, les Randonneurs Mondiaux and Union des Audax Français”.

In providing these rides, Audax Australia endeavours to provide a safe environment and enjoyable riding experience for all participants. The Club understands there are inherent risks associated with participating in rides that are conducted on public roads and thoroughfares, in conjunction with long distances that require riders to cycle during the day and night times in varying road and environmental conditions.

Audax Australia is committed to:

- Considering safety and other risks as a normal part of the conduct of the club’s activities
- Implementing a risk management framework which supports effective management of the club’s activities
- Managing risks to the Club, its office bearers, ride organisers and other volunteers, support crews, riders and the community
- Focusing on the early identification of risks and hazards and the implementing a hierarchy of controls
- Regularly reviewing the risk management framework, its implementation and its effectiveness
- Identifying suitably capable people to carry out safety and risk management
- Reviewing new processes from a safety and risk perspective prior to adoption by the club
